## The First Print and Cure System for low to medium volume mailers.

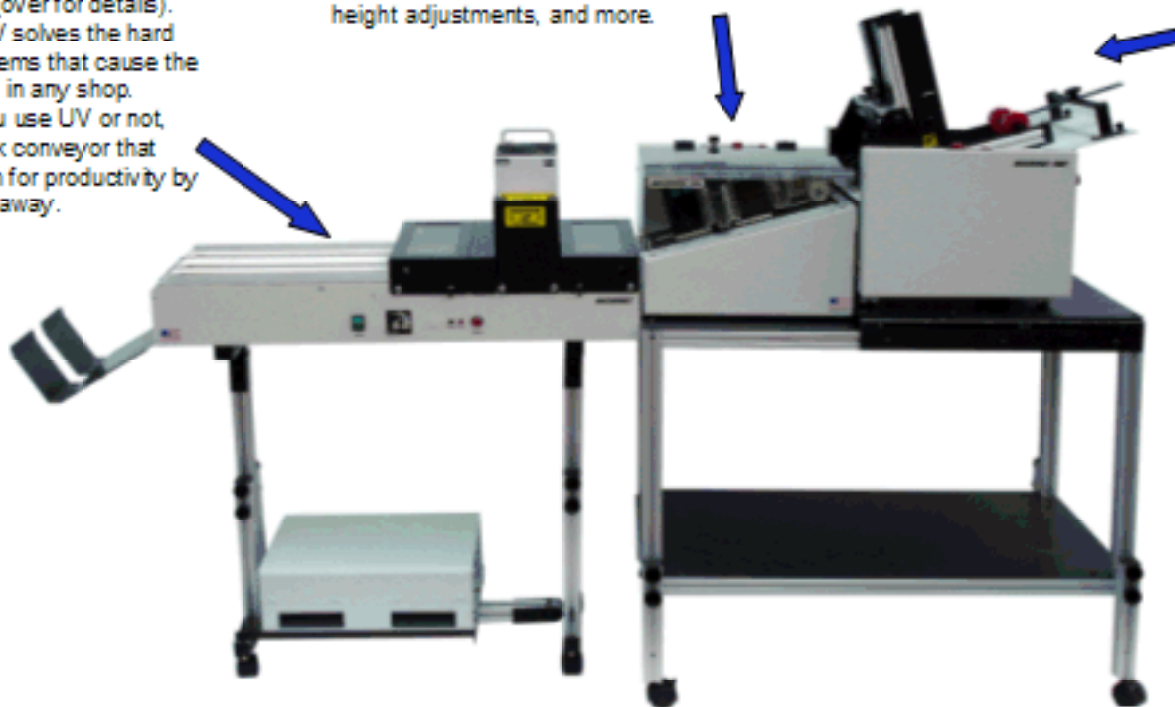

### The Modules:

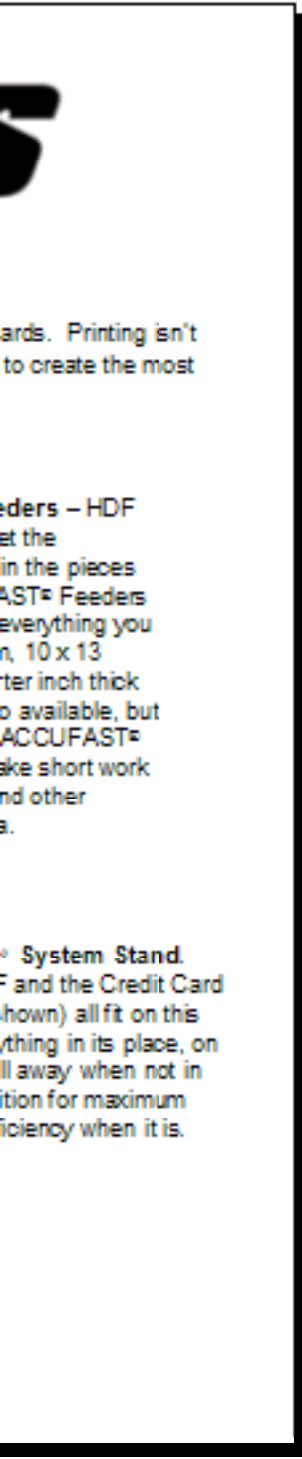
ACCUFAST® CS3/UV Curing Conveyor. (over for details). The CS3/UV solves the hard drying problems that cause the most hassle in any shop. Whether you use UV or not, this is a slick conveyor that makes room for productivity by taking work away.

ACCUFAST® P4 imager. The P4 is an amazing machine. Variable speed, 2 inches of print that can print the address and return address in one pass, vacuum transport, individual head height adjustments, and more.

ACCUFAST® feeder. Model shown. Separators, drop and go. ACCUFAST® will handle most mailers you can throw at them: envelopes a quarter of an inch thick, for example. Also not shown is the card feeder to make credit cards, and undersized media.
